

Easy Sew Protective Pockets

Materials

- Outdoor fabric or heavy weight cotton
- Bias tape
- Hook & loop circles
- Snap Hook



1

Trace your gadget either on a piece of paper or directly on the **WRONG** side of the fabric. Multiply the length by 2.5x and add 1.5cm all the way around for ease and bias.

2

Cut 2 pieces of the final size and round corners

3

Place 2 pieces **WRONG** sides together and baste.

4

Mark the foldover line of the pocket flap.

5

Cut a 12cm length of bias tape and stitch closed along the open edge. Slide a snap hook onto the tape and fold.

6

With edges together, baste tape approximately 2cm from the flap mark on the back pocket edge.

7

Add hooks & loop circles to center of the inner flap and the center of the outer front. Stitch in place.
Stitch length of bias tape along the top pocket edge.

8

Measure the outer edge of the pocket and flap and cut bias tape to fit adding 2cm. Fold bias ends up 1cm and press.

9

Pin and stitch bias tape around the entire pocket and flap edges.
